





WOMAN FORMALLY ON WELFARE QUITS 6-FIGURE CORPORATE CAREER TO HELP BLACK-OWNED BUSINESSES FOR FREE



Robin Rogers, the CEO/Founder of her 4BEBO, online directory expediently helps Blacks and others find and support Black-owned businesses for free. Robin, who grew up with seven siblings and a single mom on welfare, says that she quit her six-figure job working for a Fortune 500 company for almost 20 years because she wanted to do all she could to help create and sustain more Black-owned businesses.

After quitting her job, she assembled a team of Black professionals from across the country. While rapidly building 4BEBO's platform, Robin recalls explaining, "The pandemic made me realize that my sister's business that she's been running for several years, and my best friend's business for 20 years, both who had the same obstacle. They needed to reach a broader audience." Her concern inspired Robin to use her corporate skills, training, and abilities to focus on helping her own community instead of a corporation's bottom line. She continues, "God has blessed me to understand that the best rewards come from helping others without asking for anything in return."

The 4BEBO based in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina, is more than another directory of Black-owned businesses. Her brand's social media pages and YouTube channel, enable entrepreneurs to connect. 4BEBO, an abbreviation for "4 Black Entrepreneurs and Business Owners," is available to download for free from the Google Play store and Apple's iOS App Store to find and support Black-owned businesses nationwide.

For the record: Robin who was ridiculed in school for being poor, resulted in her frequent absenteeism. Shy of a few credits, she quit school and soon passed her GED exam for college enrollment. Despite paying for some of her college expenses, landing on the Dean's list and being blessed with four grant scholarships, her financial problems prevailed.

In retrospect, being compelled to quit college and later being employed at an entry-level Fortune 500 company, employee served her well. As a brilliant professional earning six figures through 2022, by the time she became self-employed, she was successfully employed at three Fortune 500 companies. By 2022 well aware that her peers had yet to experience their projected success, caused Robin to consider helping more Black businesses. The company also has affiliates in Tampa, Florida, and Dayton, Ohio.

Schomburg Library's Art Celebration



Black History is Art History noted with the 2023 Schomburg Library celebration of numerous black comic series in which great authentic real-life images and inventions were also chronicled in the 1970s Golden Legacy series featured in Ebony Magazine. Yours Truly, publisher of New York Global.Biz, recalls during the late 1970s when she came across Publisher Bert Fitzgerald's Golden Legacy series revealing Matthew Henson, Benjamin Banneker, Lewis Latimer, Harriet Tubman, Granville T. Woods, and several other Black inventors. The names of their inventions were concealed and seldom used as classroom studies, as a tool to advocate Black curriculum studies in US, public schools, year-round. Nor were they available for reading in schools and libraries that would have likely during the past 50 years influentially helped eradicate racism.




Black and Puerto Rican heritage Arturo Schomburg's mixed ancestry was also that which inspired him to research his ethnic and cultural background.





SAG-AFTRA ACTOR KING MELVIN BROWN'S MOVIE REVIEWS



BLACK ADAM Wow! Evolving through the Rock's command performance and stark dark brutalizing special effects reminisces, are among reasons Black Adam. initially intrigued me for about a half hour of this blockbuster film. Black Adam's

rebellious vengeance consequentially targets a sadistic king who murdered his 12-year-old son. As Black Adam transforms into an uncontrollable powerful flying God suddenly defeating, if not escaping the U.S. Military, how shocking it became that Black Adam was still and remains a threat to the U.S. Military. Their attempt to subdue and learn that they'd never control Adam, occurred as Black Adam denounced, "I kneel before no one! I died as a slave and was reborn as a God King," and a striking dynamic Godly reference, uttered by a human. Black Adam's arrogance caused the Military to awkwardly attack him, during several surrealistic breathtaking superhero scenes. Fierce battles lured other U.S. resentful superheroes...some likewise, were aptly fierce as Black Adam, providing there were two or more of them challenging him. Likewise, his new fight partners were combating greedy lords pillaging and enslaving Black Adam's country. It took a mother and her son's plot to warrant Black Adam's triumph against his foes. Finally, as the fierce God King of his country, Black Adam's reacted to another plot. Enter award-winner Viola Davis' cameo appearance and warning. I give Black Adam a 9.



ELVIS

One of the greatest Elvis Presley's film starring Tom Hanks, one of my best actors. As Elvis Presley's promoter, Tom as Snowman, the greatest illusionist promoter, received Elvis' permission to make Elvis Presley, the world's greatest entertainer. During his adolescence

his film was shot in Elvis' parents' small Nashville, Tenessee home, schools, and community centers where he often practiced singing, guitar playing, and dancing. The film depicts Elvis, experiencing the Holy Ghost from the churches he attended, his soul sounds, and showmanship from R&B groups he hung out with. That 1950s/60s era racistly precluded Blacks from being the face of America's music. Yet, Elvis, being White, exposed mainstream gospel and R&B. According to the film, Black people did not resent Elvis. Personally, I was ecstatic seeing hundreds of Blacks cast in this film. Amid Snowman's gambling debts, in the 1970s Elvis, was the world's most famous entertainer entrapped by Snowman's gambling debts and mob payments. Forced to play in Vegas' top casinos during his career heyday, deprived Elvis of his often-requested performance tours. Though he survived as an honorable discharged U.S. Army draftee, this fascinating film became a harrowing expose of who, what, and why Presley's demise occurred, and his heavy drug addiction. I give Elvis an 8.



WOMAN KING

CONGRATULATIONS! Viola Davis' General Nanscica's, Woman King, is the 2023 super blockbuster Best Actress Academy Awards winner. Expect Woman King's Best supporting cast members, costumes, film, music, and other awards. Remarkably, this epic film portrays a Black woman's heart-wrenching experiences, challenges, and enduring obstacles. Her pain and shame. at her lowest stage, and bearing a child from a brutal, savage, rape, later rose like a phoenix,

from the ashes to a Godly Warrior. This powerful message may overwhelm women feeling powerless, as a solution to their similar fate. Personally, I felt such pride that every woman might feel being Black or White. The brilliant title, Woman King, is so powerful, eventually, a woman surpasses the queen's title, giving her insurmountable victory for her country, typifying a king's accomplishment by a woman! Woman King is an exciting subject matter, as the film's historic twists and turns are unpredictable, scene after scene. The most pivotal earth-shattering moments occurred after Viola and her female Warriors won a major battle. I rated a 10 for Woman King.

Written and directed by Josh Alexander, John Legend, among several executive producers, of Loudmouth's resolute documentary features Sharpton's Brooklyn Baptist preacher's charismatic oratory. Legendary Pianist James P. Johnson



Yours Truly's 2022 cultural music celebration features the renowned pianist and music composer James P. Johnson, of New Brunswick, NJ. Last winter, I vaguely considered responding to dozens of my New Brunswick High School's Alma Matas seeking more James P Johnson and other New Brunswick legends bios. In 1987, I briefly read

some of James Price Johnson's bio, while researching data for what became my Tribute for the famous ragtime/classical jazz pianist Eubie Blake on his what would have been 103rd birthday that aired on noted Bob Law's WWRL Radio, Show, with Rosetta Lenoire and Emma Kemp. Finally, 35 years later, I'm gratefully sharing New Brunswick's, Grammy, Jazz, Hall of Fame James P. Johnson, the world's leading creator of stride piano and jazz piano musician, facts from those archives. Born in 1894, his father William H. Johnso, was a storekeeper and mechanic and his mom Josephine, a maid and church choir singer. As their age 5-year-old child prodigy, he quickly memorized the piano chords and instructions his mother taught, after she brought home a piano. About 25 years later, Johnson branded Ragtime music conversion into stride piano, while pioneering swing jazz piano's popularity, well into his early 1950s.

At age nine, Johnson began following other piano players, after his family relocated to Jersey City. That year, after he was hired to perform at a neighbor's party, he was hired to play piano at a brothel, thus initiating more brothels and bar gigs prepping him for what became his litany of live performances, record and film composition studio performances, among symphony and orchestra concerts receiving throughout the early 1950s, He was influenced by and followed Eubie Blake and Lucky Roberts when his family moved to San Juan Hill, Harlem. By 1914 his interest in other music genres, included studies with Vino Ziannio, an Italian pianist and ragtime pianist Charlie Cherry. Meeting Lila White, performing during at a Newark, NJ show, led to their marriage three years later. In 1918 he and friend Willie the Lion Smith were

featured on joint music tours.

To date, musicologists equate Johnson's music mastery, as an indispensable bridge between Rag time and Jazz His legacy His legacy students were Fats Waller, Art Tatum, Donald Lambert, Louis Pat Flowers, Cliff Jackson, Duke Ellington, Count Basie, Ralph Sutton, Charlie Parker, Joe Turner and others as his students.



At 23, he recorded piano rolls for Perfection, Aeolian and Artempo Records produced and recorded his Runnin Wild's musical's Old Fashion Love popular hit and introduced The Charleston his world's famous popular hit. His 1932 Yamekraw - A Negro Rhapsody, followed by Harlem Synphony's Negro Rhapsody and 1935 Symphony in Brown were among Johnson's 400 piano slides and 300 music compositions for recordings, clubs, concerts and film compositions, includes Carolina Strut and The Charleston, the unofficial Roaring 20s national anthem. Major stars appeared in more than one of Johnson's music scores for Show of Shows; John Barrymore, Douglas Fairbanks, Jr., Myrna Loy; *Dancing Lady,* John Crawford, Fred Astaire, 1933; *The Big Road Cast of 1938*, W.C. Fields, Dorothy and Bob Hope. In the 1930s W.C. Handy's Black Swan Records recorded his music. Known for playing consecutive nights, Ethel Waters said, "Johnson's music made you sing until your tonsils came out." As music director of his Plantation Days Reviews. his show experienced an extended five-year tour after Plantation Days Reviews was held in England. also featured in England.

Meanwhile civic records still list poet Joyce Kilmer, Kirk Douglas, and Donald Highsmith as New Brunswick's few famous persons. Yet U.S History differs given music genius Johnson's various Hall of Fame Awards in his heyday and posthumously

Brown, Muhammad Ali Adam Clayton Powell, Jr, John Lewis, etc. works. Our Publisher's Statement in the 2018 Record Breakers Issue of New York Global.Biz (NYGB) responded to shallow political and media pundits doubting Sharpton's major film or documentary offers. 




WHO CELEBRATED BLACK MARZELL DIXON, AS ELITE'S RUTGERS U'S 1952 CUM LAUDE TWO YEARS PRIOR TO U.S. SUPREME COURTS BROWN VS. FERGUSON'S U.S. PUBLIC SCHOOL DESEGREGATION

In 2021, Yours Truly's awestruck elation wallowed in despair, finally resulting in mixed emotions after receiving and pondering what to do with my then 73 years young, cousin's Commemorative Biography celebrating the 2021st Centennial Year, since the birth of her father, my Uncle Marzell Dixon's in 1921.

As author of 1981s Friends of Robeson's play, based on a summer evening at Paul Robeson Village New Brunswick, NJ with my son, Adam, his cousins, and friends, at least once a year, I cite Paul Robeson, as Rutgers University's greatest Black student. Earnestly, decades later I'm unqualified to document my Uncle Marzell Dixon's academic achievement at Rutgers.

Retrospectively, because the 1954s U.S. School Desegregation Law, Brown vs. The Board of Education was not in place, perhaps then elite, Rutgers University's avoided celebrating a Black student, (then classified as negro) as their 1952 Cum-laude graduate. He traveled from his nearby South River, NJ, home as an honor graduate from South River High School. In 1952, Paul Robeson was still politically banned from the United States.





breakthrough, providing free ice skating lessons, together with academic studies for teenage girls in Harlem. Wow! advancement in jumps is from American skaters, and 2023 U.S. National Ice Skating Champion, Ilia Malinin,







CONGRATULATIONS GILFORD MONROSE, NYCS FIRST FAITH-BASED EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR COMMUNITY LEADER



New York Global.Biz (NYGB Black) History celebrates Pastor Monrose Gilford, appointed in 2022 as NYCs first Faith Based Executive Director. Pastor Gifford's success as Brooklyn's Community Faith Based Leader, became a critical necessity for all NYCs boroughs. Last January, I finally arrived at Pastor's Gifford's strategically addressed Anti-gun Violence prioritized initiatives and solutions featuring clergy, community, law enforcement, academia, media, and mental health leaders. At least 500 people attended and feasted on a Southern and Continental dinner at that event held at NYCs recently built huge police academy.

Pastor Gilford, an Advisory Leadership Council Member for Habitat and Volunteer Chaplain for MTA has a Theology and Bible Studies BA from Nyack College. In 2005 he became a Pastor at the Mount Zion Church of God Seventh Day, in East Flatbush, Brooklyn. He is the Alumni Chair for the "We All Brooklyn" non-profit, respected for bringing diverse leaders together, to solve life issues affecting their communities. Though his NYCs landscape massively increased, serving four other boroughs. Pastor Gilford's faith-based leadership is immeasurable, also as founder and president of the 67th Precinct Clergy Council.

Since his first term, Gilford always immaculately debonair, sporting a bow-tie. Tentatively agreed to our NYGB or our 2015-16 WPAT Radio Singers Songwriters' Show, (fundraising for survivors of police and community brutality victims interviews. He hosted Mayor's Adam's Anti-Violence and Anti-Gun Public press conferences, candle-light ceremonies, etc. My apologetic emails for not attending, included asking if he knew that I emailed Mayor DiBlasio, my Church Homeless Shelter Plan that his office advised me to resend.


Nevertheless, it's pleasing to know that Mayor Eric Adams did implement a far more intensive Faith Based Community Housing Plan for NYC. My Church Homeless Shelter Plan would give Brooklyn's Bishop Owhe's churches and numerous brownstones to larger churches' stability. After I was invited to speak with them, a female Rev. Scott and I met with about 25

Black ailing church leaders, seeking means to restore or increase their membership, since Hurricane Sandy. NYGBs small investor, Leroy Smith, was pleased that Bishop Owhe agreed with me at the end of our session, when I proposed a Church Homeless Shelter Plan. My plan emphasized that which was more affordable, in view of NYCs Mayor Bloomberg's concern about reducing thousands of employed and Hurricane Sandy NYC homeless adults, among other homeless persons.

Whereas My Church Homeless Plan foresaw eight to 10 homeless persons residing in a brownstone, instead of sleeping in front of churches which became the norm. They have 24 hours accessibility, receive mental-health counseling, job training for employment, and will be encouraged to further their education or college. They'll be responsible for some household chores. The minister as executive director has an assistant. A maximum of two years in a Church Homeless Shelter Plan should help them resume their quality of life elsewhere. The goal of the program was to reduce NYCs homeless budget.

HOUSE MINORITY LEADER HAKEEM JEFFRIES SPONSORS HISTORIC BILL TO **DECRIMINALIZE MARIJUANA**



According to US Black Congressional Caucus two months in office, Hakeem Jeffries, the Hon. HR Congressman, and Minority Speaker from Brooklyn, New York, urgently challenged Congress to decriminalize national marijuana users.

By 1874, the young Black U.S. HR Democrat Congressman Robert Elliott's oratorical and written appeal denouncing America's segregationists prevailing substandard housing, education employment, health care, legal and consumer rights solidified as the first critically needed 1875 Civil Rights Bill. Consequently, a few years later the U.S. Supreme Court struck down that bill, denying that the U.S. Consists the 1875 bill that does not apply to private businesses. unlike Rev. Dr. King's 1965 Civil Rights Act, applicable to nearly every industry, private and otherwise. As reported by the Congressional Black Caucus this is huge! House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries sponsors historic bill to decriminalize marijuana.

The war on marijuana has cost the U.S. billions of dollars! It wrongfully targets Black Americans and prevents them from getting jobs, access to food assistance, college grants, and more. This bill is essential to end systemic racism. The tax revenue from legalized and decriminalized marijuana could fund our schools, hospitals, and social services. Experts say 63% of Americans support decriminalizing marijuana and his bill could BOOST our economy! With enough pressure from good New York Democrats, we can show widespread support to pass Hakeem Jeffries' bill. This type of public pressure will only work with a massive petition delivered to the Senate.


